



## Minor Fishing Harbour at Shankarpur (Stage-I), Dist. – Purba Medinipur



Shankarpur was a small fishing hamlet in the early eighties having started mechanized fishing activities in the district. In order to facilitate increase in the momentum of marine fishing through mechanization, the Department of Fisheries, Government of West Bengal established the first Fishing Harbour of

the State at Shankarpur in 1987 to provide infrastructural facilities like landing, berthing & repair jetties along with auction hall, workshop, net mending shed, roads, drainage etc. for 150 nos. mechanized fishing vessels (MFV). The Company successfully completed the construction of the Fishing Harbour in 1987.

Cost of completion : Rs. 241 lakh
