



Up-gradation of Navigability of Samudrakhal,

In order to facilitate continuous movement of fishing vessels all through the tidal phases, the Department of Fisheries, Government of West Bengal, proposed dredging of the inner channel and the bay mouth to improve the navigational conditions. The up-gradation of Navigability of Samudra Khal

allows unhindered movement of MFVs at all tide conditions without idle waiting at the sea mouth during low tide condition . This also helps in value addition to marine fish catch and more earning to the fishermen. There has been huge social benefit in the form of enhancement of socio-economic



condition of the poor fishermen, besides aversion of accidents during storms as the vessels are able to take safe refuge in the inner channel at any tide condition. Cost of the Project: Rs. 1226.47 Lakh.
